





#### LADY DAY

March has been and gone already! In former times March 25th meant a New Year. This was the day when Mary, probably a teenager, was told by the Archangel Gabriel that she was expecting the Christ Child. It was precisely nine months before Christmas Day. The occasion was called 'The Annunciation', which was another way of saying 'the announcement'. There were many paintings of Gabriel and Mary, the winged archangel giving his message to the seated girl, rather overwhelmed. The composition is often entitled 'Ecce ancilla Domini', Latin for 'behold the handmaid of the Lord' (Luke 1.38).

The early church goes on with the story, so that we have Mary's response to the archangel's announcement (Luke 1.46). In Latin it begins with the word 'Magnificat', which was in its turn a translation from Luke's original Greek: 'megalunei'. This meant something like 'shout it out loud!' It calls to mind a modern Rock Group rather than the chaste tones of choral evensong in an Anglican cathedral. We often gloss over the starkness of what this Nazareth girl meant. Coming from the north of Israel, believed to be an area of social deprivation, Mary says that God is turning things upside down. The rich can no longer be sure of their privileged position. Mary's original words were translated as: 'he hath filled the hungry with good things, and the rich he hath sent, empty, away.' This is not the outpouring of a modern political rabble-rouser; these are words from a 2,000 year-old gospel.





#### DID YOU KNOW .....?

In Old England, when customers got unruly the bartender would yell "mind your pints and quarts and settle down". This is where we get the phrase "Mind your Ps and Qs".

Another historical pub-related fact. Pub regulars would have a whistle baked into the handle or rim of their ceramic cups. When they needed a refill they would use the whistle to get some service. Hence the phrase "wet your whistle".

The phrase "paint the town red" most likely owes its origin to one legendary night of drunkenness. In 1837, the Marquis of Waterford—a known lush and mischief maker—led a group of friends on a night of drinking through the English town of Melton Mowbray. The bender culminated in vandalism after Waterford and his fellow revellers knocked over flowerpots, pulled knockers off doors and broke the windows of some of the town's buildings. To top it all off, the mob literally painted a tollgate, the doors of several homes and a swan statue with red paint.



#### St Mary's Church Badwell Ash Clock Restoration Update

The restoration of the clock funded by The Heritage
Lottery Fund is continuing apace. The fully restored
and re-gilded clock face was put back on the church just before Christmas

and the Turret Clock itself should be back in the church within the next few weeks. Haward Horological, the clock restorers who are undertaking the work, will also be installing a self-winding mechanism and a night silencing gizmo that will prevent the clock from chiming during the night. As far as we're aware, once the clock has been restored this will be the first time in over 40 years that the village will be able to hear the hourly chimes which will be struck on the C16 tenor bell in the belfry.



To celebrate the restoration of the clock, the Badwell Ash History Society in association with the Parochial Church Council, are going to be holding a grand opening and **History Exhibition** on **Saturday April 29<sup>th</sup>**. The Exhibition will include displays about the clock and its history along with the on-going research that the History Society are currently undertaking about your village and, back by popular demand, the Recorder Books of the village history in the 60s, 70s, 80s and later. Please make a note in your diary!

#### St Mary's Church - The Churchyard

The churchyard, the area surrounding the church, was closed for burials in 1990, as there was no more space. Only cremation memorials are now allowed to be placed there. For the last 25 years, the maintenance of the churchyard and the cutting of the grass has been the responsibility of the Parochial Church Council with ad hoc financial assistance from the Parish Council. Late last year the Parochial Church Council decided that this arrangement should be put on a more formal footing and put in place a legal arrangement whereby the maintenance was formerly transferred to The Parish Council. At their meeting in January, The Parish Council resolved to transfer this responsibility to Mid-Suffolk Council.
