



THE HOPE of CHRISTMAS.

As we leave the month of November behind, a month given for poignant remembrance in so many different ways, we approach Christmas and with it a time once more of hope. For us Christmas comes at the darkest time of year, it is after all the time of the midwinter solstice, and its message of the light of God coming into the world makes a great deal of sense when the world around us is so dark. Wherever we turn we are so often seemingly confronted by a sense of despair in the face of so much destructiveness and darkness. Every generation has probably felt the same way in the 2000 years since Jesus, and no doubt long before then. It was into this world that Jesus came and was heralded as 'the light of the world,' a hope when there seemed no hope at all. The darkness of this time of year allows us to be grateful for the light, to appreciate both the natural and artificial light, with them our sight is not limited by our environment, but we can see the way to go. For thousands of years people have feared the dark, associating it with physical and spiritual terrors. Yet at the same time as they have looked to avoid the dark, there has been a sense in which the light is enhanced by the darkness, and that darkness contributes to the magnificence of light. Perhaps we experience that at the most magical of times, Christmas Eve, when we anticipate Christmas, and the time of anticipation is more evocative than Christmas morning itself. Darkness can signify a time of waiting, of expectancy and yearning, of looking forward

with hope to a future yet unknown. The Christmas season can be a dark and lonely time for many people, with even greater feelings of stress and guilt than usual, a time borne by many with stoical fortitude at best, and yet for others cruel depression at worst. Let us all this Christmas in our workplaces, our communities and our everyday lives look to those who might just welcome that short visit, the listening ear or that extra word of encouragement.

On that first Christmas there was no room at the Inn for the baby Christ, but there will be room for all at our variety of different services at all our six churches this Christmas as we join together in celebrating the birth of Jesus. There literally is 'room for all,' because God welcomes each and every one of us. He does not want anyone to be turned away. For those of you reading this, whether your Christian faith is strong, faltering or you have none at all, there will be a warm welcome at any of the Benefice Services this Advent and Christmas season; be it a contemplative service of Compline, an informal colourful Crib service or the mystery of the Communion Service itself, including our informal Christmas

Day Communions for all the family.

Christmas is a time to celebrate hope, may the awareness of that hope be rejuvenated in our lives, those of our family and friends and communities, and in the wider world as we celebrate the birth of a child in a stable in a remote part of the world some 2000 years ago.





St. Mary's Church, Badwell Ash

Having successfully completed the clock restoration in the tower, The Parochial Church Council is now looking to move on to the next project. There have been a number of Church and History Exhibitions held in St. Mary's recently and this has highlighted a lack of toilet and kitchen facilities for visitors to the church. So as a result of a number of requests, the PCC contacted John Stebbing, Architects to prepare a feasibility study to provide these facilities. John Stebbing was chosen as they are currently carrying out a similar scheme for the PCC at Bardwell. A number of options were considered but the PCC selected the proposal for a disabled W.C. in the base of the tower and a small kitchenette at the west end of the South Aisle. (Proposed plan follows on another page).

The Diocese is now reviewing the project which also includes resolving the severe damp in the South Aisle. They will need to approve it before we start to look for the funding to carry out the work. Grants are available but St. Mary's will need to raise a significant amount of money themselves. The approximate cost of the scheme is between £35,000 and £40,000 so once The Diocese have given the PCC the "green light" to move on to the next stage, it will be "all hands to the pump" to try and find the money! St. Mary's has also been very grateful to two of our parishioners this year for helping us to maintain and preserve the fabric of the church. The first is James Taylor of TMJ Interiors who very kindly made and donated the two new oak gates to the churchyard. They were designed by a member of the congregation to be as close a match as possible to the originals. The second is Roger Castro from Badwell Hall who very generously restored a "Peal Board"* from the early C20 and the "Thomas Blackerby Charity Board" which dates from the C18, free of charge. Both have now been returned to the church and re-hung. Roger has also restored the two chests in the church; one dates from the C19 and the other is Jacobean dating from the C17.

(*Note: The "Peal Board" mentioned above records an occasion on the 1st April 1907 when 5,040 changes were rung on the 5 bells at St. Mary's in just 3 hours 5 minutes by G. Smith, G. Morley, H. Morley, W Carter and H Davey.)

The Westhorpe Trust is made up of several historic funds. The oldest is from the will of Richard Brown in 1641, who lived in Westhorpe and left ten shillings a year to the poor of the parish. Income also came from the properties at Town Yard which in the 19th century contained the parish workhouse and some arable land at Botany Farm, Walsham le Willows.

The Trust's income is divided into three parts all for the benefit of the inhabitants of the parish:

1. **Westhorpe Parochial Church Council** for the upkeep and services for St Margaret's Church;

2. The **Education Foundation** which gives every child a book token at Christmas. Those at university, college or other forms of Further or Higher Education or apprenticeships are given grants each academic year towards tuition fees, travel expenses, books, computers and other essential equipment. Help is also offered with other expenses such as school uniform, books and possibly school trips for those in nursery, primary and secondary school as well as others taking educational courses.

3. The **Village Fund** provides family and personal grants for any kind of assistance, emergency payments, help with transport and heating costs, grants towards village events and many other things which need funding and are of benefit to the parish. Walsham le Willows and District WI


Members of Walsham WI are now very much more 'forensically aware' thanks to David Smith's well illustrated talk at their September meeting! Sharing anecdotes drawn from his long career, some of them quite chilling, everyone inspected their fingers with detailed scrutiny! The advances in the technical and computerised methods of finger printing have made a vast difference to the way identity is established. It was intriguing to learn that finger prints can be even more specifically individual than DNA samples and that modern compact computer storage means there is no longer any need to remove deceased prisoners 'dabs' from the archives. TV thrillers will be observed very carefully in future by our members, who watched as a fine set of prints was removed from a very large gin bottle! The competition generated a delightful array of homemade finger puppets, ranging from elephants to soldiers and even a cactus, all up against the winning penguin!

Anyone approaching the Priory Room one Wednesday evening in October might have struggled to identify the sound of more than twenty enthusiastic but completely novice washboard players! They would also have heard overwhelming gales of laughter as Walsham WI members gave in to the rhythm going something like 'gin and tonic' or as a variation 'raspberry ice-cream'! Under the tutelage of Sue Butcher, 'the washboard lady', everyone was having a really good time. Possibly it should have been classed as a special therapy, I think it did us all good.

The success of the Suffolk Community Barn Owl Project is in no small part down to the dedication of those improving the local farming practices and to the monitoring teams who risk venturing up ladders and reaching in past some very sharp talons and beaks. Patrick Barker's enthusiasm and extensive knowledge held his audience in close attention during his well illustrated talk at our November meeting. He explained that the impressive increase in the number of nesting owls is closely linked to the food sources available and that planting grass margins provide a ready supply of small tasty mice, shrews and voles for the owls. Boxes were often occupied almost as quickly as they were put up, though jackdaws and other interlopers had been known to attempt serious takeover bids too. Ringing the birds revealed one local barn owl travelling to Lincolnshire to set up a new nest site and a nightingale that flew to the Gambia in Africa and back twice recently. In Africa Patrick had been part of an initiative to protect the pale owls seen as unlucky and ghostly by the local population and with young people now involved and educated, this perception had now been changed.




