



COMMUNITY ALLOTMENT PROJECT Westhorpe/Finningham and surrounding villages

Please come and be involved in a new community project at the allotments behind the church in Bacton to encourage you to grow, pick and eat healthy fresh fruit and vegetables.

The idea is:

- To enable people to share the production of fruit and veg
- To encourage people of all ages and levels of experience to grow fruit and veg communally
- To share the produce and enjoy seasonal eating
- To pick and process the fruit, making jams etc.
- To encourage families with small gardens and limited knowledge to join others who can give advice and assistance with growing various produce

At the moment I have a double plot (about 50m x 14m) and I believe we could have more space if required. The land has been ploughed and 30% rotavated. A third of the plot will be for soft fruit (black currents already planted – gooseberries and autumn raspberries), another third for plum trees (awaiting delivery) and the other third for either **group or individual** planting. There is also space to have a grassed area for the children to enjoy etc. There will space for rhubarb (awaiting delivery), sweet corn, courgettes, pumpkins, butternut squash, cut flowers and all those things that take up too much room in your garden – experiment with companion growing I am slowly collecting manure from local farmers and have planted a lot of soft fruit cuttings. The ground is very light and easy to work. I am looking at growing things that are not labour intensive and easy to maintain.

So what is the catch you ask?

Well water is a problem and when the fruit comes it will need picking. You can do as much or as little as you like but the hard digging is done using a rotavator. Help will be needed for planting and especially weeding (hoeing) and keeping the grass cut.

This is a long term project and the soft fruit and especially the fruit trees will take time to mature – I am unsure how many people will be interested and hopefully enough to make this a worthwhile project

News from Thurston Community College

Proposed cuts to free school bus provision by Suffolk County Council could remove the choice of parents in many of our catchment villages to send their children to Thurston Community College. Suffolk County Council is proposing to stop providing free bus transport to Thurston Community College to residents that live nearer to another school, even though Thurston will remain the catchment school for all the children in these villages.

This means that children who wish to continue attending their catchment school will have to pay £960 a year for a school bus or find some other way to get to school. We feel this is a huge burden for our families and will mean that a choice of school will only be available to those who can afford it.

We hope all residents will respond to the Suffolk County Council consultation to oppose the proposed changes. Even if you do not have school-age children, this will affect your community. Suffolk County Council is consulting on three options:

- 1. Change to "nearest school only" wholesale in September 2019 (all students in all year groups would no longer qualify for free transport to Thurston Community College if they live closer to a different secondary school).
- 2. Change to "nearest school only" incrementally, from September 2019 (same as above, but existing students would continue to receive free transport while new students, including siblings, do not).
- 3. Make no changes to the school travel policy, but make savings from other Suffolk County Council budgets.

Thurston Community College will continue to oppose options 1 and 2 which we have shown will not make savings but will result in additional costs elsewhere.

Option 3 is the only way to ensure that children in your village will all have the choice to attend Thurston Community College and its Sixth Form.







Income also came from the properties at Town Yard which in the 19th century contained the parish workhouse and some arable land at Botany Farm, Walsham le Willows.

The Trust's income is divided into three parts all for the benefit of the inhabitants of the parish:

1. **Westhorpe Parochial Church Council** for the upkeep and services for St Margaret's Church;

2. The **Education Foundation** which gives every child a book token at Christmas. Those at university, college or other forms of Further or Higher Education or apprenticeships are given grants each academic year towards tuition fees, travel expenses, books, computers and other essential equipment. Help is also offered with other expenses such as school uniform, books and possibly school trips for those in nursery, primary and secondary school as well as others taking educational courses.

3. COMMUNITY SPEEDWATCH—WATTISFIELD

Wattisfield Parish Council would like to set up a Community Speedwatch Group. There are concerns that there are too many speeding vehicles especially along the A143. Many other villages have set up a Community Speedwatch Group which has had many positive benefits in reducing speeding vehicles.

If Wattisfield is able to get a group established, then teams would go out in specified locations and use a speed guns to target speeding vehicles who would then be reported to the police. You may have seem teams working in other villages. Also, the group could possibly manage a Speed Indicative Device (one of the signs that flash up your speed) which would mean moving it around the village and collecting and analysing data.

However, to get this underway, we need people who are willing to give up some of their time. Before the Parish Council can take this further we need a positive commitment from at least 12 people. There are many resources available and the Parish Council can seek funding for equipment. **Would you be willing to be part of a Community Speedwatch Group and would you like to know more?**


