Income also came from the properties at Town Yard which in the 19<sup>th</sup> century contained the parish workhouse and some arable land at Botany Farm, Walsham le Willows.

The Trust's income is divided into three parts all for the benefit of the inhabitants of the parish:

1. **Westhorpe Parochial Church Council** for the upkeep and services for St Margaret's Church;

2. The **Education Foundation** which gives every child a book token at Christmas. ### Walsham le Willows and District WI (April 2018)



We were appalled to hear that, in the time we had spent listening to our speaker, three elephants had been killed in Africa...

Our Speaker was Francesca Mahoney, who runs the charity Wild Survivors aimed at protecting the elephants in Tanzania. As a child she was obsessed with wildlife, totally fascinated by animals, and in her Gap Year she spent time working in the foothills of Kilimanjaro and with animals. After working as a news journalist she gave up broadcasting and returned to Africa in 2015. There had been a huge spike in poaching of elephants, one is being killed every 15 minutes even now and they are on course for extinction by 2025. Elephants use migration routes in search of food and water and when farmlands expand this can cause problems. Elephants usually travel overnight now due to poachers and can be in quite large family groups. The farmers had resorted to poisoning them with pumpkins injected with pesticides and then informing the poachers who would pay them. However, elephants have an intense fear of bees as they target them on the thin parts of their skin. Wild Survivors is working with the farmers by providing wire around plots of land and hanging bee hives from the wire so that when the elephants try to pass through the site, the bees will attack and make them retreat and find another route. This low tech, affordable solution is working well and the farmers retain their crops, gain honey and beeswax to sell. They are now teaching farmers in other villages. The charity trains them over a year, even giving them a crash course in marketing so they gain as much as possible from their bee-culture. Wild Survivors is also developing a Buzz Box, a small machine about the size of a beaker, that uses an infra red sensor to pick up heat differences from approaching elephants and emit a buzzing noise to deter them, useful when hives have been deserted as it is portable so can be installed anywhere! Farmers are now volunteering to become beekeepers and are given up to date training. Education programmes are now in place to study elephant behaviour. Plastic is now being recycled and made into 'green wood' from which a number of things are made including the bee hives. It is durable, waterproof and malleable. Currently, testing is being carried out on local honey in order to import it into the UK. It is possible to sponsor a bee hive or beekeeping training for farmers. We left feeling moved by the evident passion and respect our speaker had for these giants. It seems we are still learning about their complex family relations and emotions. We were much impressed by both the work of the charity, making a real difference in seeking to bridge the gap, between wildlife needs and the human world needs but also by the knowledge and enthusiasm of the speaker.
