

### <u>'THEY SHALL GROW NOT OLD,</u> AS WE THAT ARE LEFT GROW OLD'

Across the world there will be commemorations during the month of November to remember the fallen of the First World War, along with those who have died in conflicts ever since. There is always a certain poign-

ancy as we remember the fallen of the first WW, because it was said at the time to be the war to end all wars; sadly that has been far from reality.

The words quoted above are used at commemoration services across the world, and come from a poem by Robert Binyon, first published in The Times newspaper in September 1914; not long into the war. The poem is titled 'For the Fallen,' and the lines are regularly used to proclaim and affirm the resolve of nations and communities neither to forget nor overlook the sacrifice of the First World War generation and beyond.

Few will know who wrote the poem, yet, and I quote; 'the poem's smooth, rhythmic flow and formal, elegant language, embody the profound sense of respect, admiration and grief that hangs over modern acts of collective remembrance.' The poem was not written by a soldier who had seen action, but by a civilian less than a month after the start of the conflict.

'For the Fallen' was written as news began to filter through of the fighting at Mons and the retreat that followed. Compared to the following years the losses of life were relatively small in 1914, but still a great shock. What is remarkable about the poem is that it anticipates the later loss of life, and seeks to give comfort to all who will endure them.



### **Commemoration of Suffolk Great War soldier's burial sites**

On this the centenary of the end of the Great War an event is being organised to recognise and pay homage to those whose death was attributable to their service in the First World War and who are buried in Suffolk under the auspices of the Commonwealth War Graves Commission.

The intention is that on the 8<sup>th</sup> of November groups of local schoolchildren will assemble at the location of the graves and will be told about the connections the soldier had with their community, his service history and the importance of remembering the sacrifice he and others made. Then at 11am, throughout the County, representatives of those same children will lay poppy crosses on each grave followed by a minute silence.

Each RBL Branch in the County are responsible for the graves in their area. Stanton branch have 10 graves in five different locations. They are as follows:

Bardwell Baptist Church.

Private Archibald Oscar Plummer (Essex Regt.) Bardwell Peter and Paul Church.

Private Alfred Harold Hazelwood (Suffolk Regt.) Rickinghall Superior St Marys Church.

Private Ernest Matthews (Labour Corps.)

Walsham Le Willows Cemetery.

Private Sidney Arthur Cracknell (Kings Royal Rifles) Private William Edgar Oxborrow (Royal West. Kents)

Wattisfield Cemetery.

Private Edward Kerry ( Royal Fusiliers) Private Ernest William Landymore (Queens West Surrey Regt.) Private George N Miller (Suffolk Regt.) Rifleman Edgar Redvers Moule (Kings Royal Rifles) Private George Rivett (Royal Fusiliers)

It has been 100 years since these brave men were buried and so little is readily known about each of them. We need to tell the children as much as we can about who they were and how they link with the communities. Do you know about these soldiers? Have you any information about relatives we might contact? If you are a local historian can you help us with any information from your research? We would be very grateful for any help you can give us. ### THE WESTHORPE TRUST

The Westhorpe Trust is made up of several historic funds. The oldest is from the will of Richard Brown in 1641, who lived in Westhorpe and left ten shillings a year to the poor of the parish. Income also came from the properties at Town Yard which in the 19<sup>th</sup> century contained the parish workhouse and some arable land at Botany Farm, Walsham le Willows.

The Trust's income is divided into three parts all for the benefit of the inhabitants of the parish:

1. **Westhorpe Parochial Church Council** for the upkeep and services for St Margaret's Church;

2. The **Education Foundation** which gives every child a book token at Christmas. Those at university, college or other forms of Further or Higher Education or apprenticeships are given grants each academic year towards tuition fees, travel expenses, books, computers and other essential equipment. Help is also offered with other expenses such as school uniform, books and possibly school trips for those in nursery, primary and secondary school as well as others taking educational courses.

3. The **Village Fund** provides family and personal grants for any kind of assistance, emergency payments, help with transport and heating costs, grants towards village events and many other things which need funding and are of benefit to the parish.
