#### **CHURCH ORGANS**

Across our Benefice we are very blessed in having an Organ in each of the six churches as well as extremely competent Organists to play them, to whom I am always most grateful for giving of their time in sharing their gifts and talents with us. It is worth remembering that there are many churches across our Diocese which no longer have an organ suitable for church services, or if they do, then sadly nobody capable of playing; a CD is never quite the same!

Recently we have seen the completion of a replacement organ in St Mary's Church Walsham. Thanks go out to ALL who have been involved in whatever way towards fundraising to meet the costs. It is now intended that the 'new' organ will be dedicated at the Benefice Epiphany Service in the New Year, a service at which the Diocesan Director of Ordinands, Reverend Tim Jones will be preaching.

Observing the organ being painstakingly put together, led me to reflect that we can draw some lessons for ourselves from their construction. All organs are made up of different parts, each with a different function and purpose, just as all of us, whether as members of God's Church or the wider society also have different functions and purposes.

Some of the pipes in an organ are small enough to be held in the hand, other parts are big and imposing. Some parts are obvious, clear and visible to all. Others, including I understand the most crucial, are never seen, hidden out of sight deep inside the organ. Some parts might seem inconsequential, but, if just one small part ceases to function, the whole instrument suffers.

So too, with us. Some have conspicuous tasks to perform in both the church and community we serve; other tasks might be carried out with no-one ever getting to hear. Some of us might be tempted to think, what can I do? Surely I don't matter. Or we might be tempted to leave tasks to others, to those we consider more qualified than ourselves. Yet God always has something for us to do; it may seem inconsequential – like some of the hidden parts of the organ – a phone call we have been meaning to make, a letter we have not yet replied to, a dispute that really does need settling.

In the same way, we, as members of God's Church are nothing without the breath of God, the Holy Spirit filling our lives and giving us the power and energy to function as we should.

Here is a verse from a favourite hymn of mine written in the  $19^{\rm th}$  century and based around psalm 150

'O Praise ye the Lord, all things that give sound; Each jubilant chord re-echo around; Loud organs, His glory forth tell in deep tone, And, sweet harp, the story of what He has done.'

As a Christian it is my hope and prayer that all of our six church organs will not only lead our worship, but that their voices will also sound out God's love, power and glory.

#### September 2018

The work of the Women's Aid Refuge in Bury St Edmunds was brought vividly to life for members at our September meeting as our speakers bravely recounted their own experiences. Tracy and Kay each described different areas on which they now worked with clients, as they tried to rebuild disrupted lives following the trauma of domestic abuse. The refuge they described was so much more than a safe house as they tackled addiction issues and every kind of life skill that many of us take for granted. It was interesting that their work with community services and counselling sometimes extended beyond a stay in the refuge, as establishing and maintaining a new lifestyle can take a considerable length of time and can include several family members. Tracy and Kay delivered their talk with cheerful good humour and outlined all the different groups and sessions they run at the Refuge. President Jeannie Bloomfield then explained just why she supported the refuge and the campaign to end violence against women so strongly and shared her own tragic story. It was gratifying to see all three speakers had eventually turned their lives around and were putting their experiences back to work for good outcomes for others who found themselves in a similar position.

#### October 2018

Several gentlemen joined our members this month. One of whom, with flower pot in hand, stepped forward to tell us how he had developed his love of plants, gardening and the wonder of the seasons. On the way we had a personal glimpse of what it was like to witness the Coronation. The 1911 Coronation of George 5<sup>th</sup>, for this was Brian Thurlow in the guise of "Mr Potter" the gardener, born 1900 and guardian of the knot garden at a fictitious "Glebe House". Brian, in a lengthy sustained character performance, transported us back to the years before the first World War and thence forward to our own era. At times, such was the detail, as we toured the walled garden we could almost smell the roses or the scent of freshly cut grass. The boyish enthusiasm gave way to deep respect for the cycle of growth as the gardener's boy became the Head Gardener and finished with retirement in his beloved knot garden, first created on a plate for the Flower Show so many years ago.

Income also came from the properties at Town Yard which in the 19<sup>th</sup> century contained the parish workhouse and some arable land at Botany Farm, Walsham le Willows.

The Trust's income is divided into three parts all for the benefit of the inhabitants of the parish:

1. **Westhorpe Parochial Church Council** for the upkeep and services for St Margaret's Church;

2. The **Education Foundation** which gives every child a book token at Christmas. Those at university, college or other forms of Further or Higher Education or apprenticeships are given grants each academic year towards tuition fees, travel expenses, books, computers and other essential equipment. Help is also offered with other expenses such as school uniform, books and possibly school trips for those in nursery, primary and secondary school as well as others taking educational courses.

3.
