EASTER

Which is more important Christmas or Easter? A question I am sometimes asked, and to a certain extent it is chicken and egg. Certainly Easter is the most ancient, being significantly older than Christmas. We do not know when Easter first began to be observed as an annual festival. There is no reference to an annual celebration in first century writings; indeed the date for celebrating Easter varied considerably for a number of centuries and was not universally resolved until the 600s, but the proclamation 'God raised Jesus' was central to Christianity from the beginning. Celebrating Sunday as the Lords Day, every Sunday, celebrates the resurrection, and reflects its central importance.

'We are an Easter People' is a phrase we often hear used to describe Christians. Our question must be, 'do we live our lives as 'Easter People?' Do we show in our own lives the joyful belief that God loves us so much that He sent His only Son to die for us and to rise again so that we can share in His risen life?

In Eastertide we think and talk especially of 'new life.' As we emerge from the season of Lent, we also emerge from winter into spring and we look forward to summer. As Christians we are expected to bear witness to that new life in our own lives. As a Church, we pray for signs of that new life in all that we do, as we look forward in hope and joy.

For those who might declare themselves being without faith, Easter still has something to offer; a time to check where we are in life, and what the future should, does, and more importantly will hold for us. Easter is constantly around us, no more so than in those unexpected gestures of caring, of love and of hope. But of course for the Christian Church and its followers Easter is a time to celebrate the risen Lord Jesus; a time to renew our trust and hope in our Saviour. $(Cont \rightarrow)$

When the speaker Peter Davidson lifted a little papier-mache model of a traditional timbered cottage from its box, there was an audible mumour of recognition. However, as the talk progressed it was clear we did not appreciate just how strong the local connections were to "Dr Barnados", whose little fund-raising box took the form of the cottage. Nor did we realise just what an enormous operation, in caring for "destitute children", Barnados eventually became. We learned of the links from the cities to rural Suffolk as children were 'boarded out' to foster parents before often being relocated to Canada in huge numbers. Boys frequently moved to agricultural work in the prairies of Manitoba and the girls trained to iron, launder and cook, became ladies maids in the rapidly growing and affluent cities like Toronto As every child was photographed on arrival at Dr Barnados, a new art at that time, we saw some very telling pictures and were amazed to hear that at one time there were twenty nine 'home children' living with families in Wickham Skieth. Walsham too, was early and instrumental in the introduction of this practice. In a carefully researched and illustrated talk, Peter Davidson told a story that, as he said, "deserved to be told". It was a mixture of local and social history at its best.

The Westhorpe Trust is made up of several historic funds. The oldest is from the will of Richard Brown in 1641, who lived in Westhorpe and left ten shillings a year to the poor of the parish. Income also came from the properties at Town Yard which in the 19th century contained the parish workhouse and some arable land at Botany Farm, Walsham le Willows.

The Trust's income is divided into three parts all for the benefit of the inhabitants of the parish:

1. **Westhorpe Parochial Church Council** for the upkeep and services for St Margaret's Church;

2. The **Education Foundation** which gives every child a book token at Christmas. Those at university, college or other forms of Further or Higher Education or apprenticeships are given grants each academic year towards tuition fees, travel expenses, books, computers and other essential equipment. Help is also offered with other expenses such as school uniform, books and possibly school trips for those in nursery, primary and secondary school as well as others taking educational courses.

3. The **Village Fund** provides family and personal grants for any kind of assistance, emergency payments, help with transport and heating costs, grants towards village events and many other things which need funding and are of benefit to the parish.
