

barrier to people committing themselves to the Christian Faith; basically, it is never too late. This is the second time that Bishop Mike has conducted such a service within the Benefice in the space of just over a year, and we are grateful to him. I am always very much open to anyone coming forward for Baptism or/and Confirmation, and as such will be glad to hear from those who feel that this may be something they wish to pursue. Elsewhere in this magazine are details of a forthcoming Bible study to be held at the home of retired Priest, Reverend Pam Robson, which is open to EVERYONE, regardless of where they may be on their journey of faith, or indeed for those who might declare that they have none at all.

Age is truly no barrier to the Christian Faith as we are reminded later during the month of August when the Christian Church worldwide celebrates the Feast Day of the 4th/5th century St Augustine. Born a Roman African, and an extremely gifted scholar, Augustine spent his formative years living a wild and dissolute lifestyle, coupled with a firm conviction as a declared atheist. His father had been a pagan, whilst his mother lived the life of a devout Christian. It was her influence that caused Augustine to become increasingly anxious about his spiritual life, and it is said that he began to pray to God with the words; 'please make me chaste, but not just yet.'

St Augustine was finally baptised, Ordained as a Priest and having founded the Monastic Order of Augustinians, was eventually persuaded to become Bishop of Hippo, which is today modern Algeria. Augustine is widely regarded as one of the most influential of all the early Christian Fathers, whose extensive writings are still much quoted, published and used by scholars even to this day.

And finally; during the month of September and early October each of our six churches will be hosting their annual Harvest Festivals, and a warm

THE WESTHORPE TRUST

The Westhorpe Trust is made up of several historic funds. The oldest is from the will of Richard Brown in 1641, who lived in Westhorpe and left ten shillings a year to the poor of the parish. Income also came from the properties at Town Yard which in the 19th century contained the parish workhouse and some arable land at Botany Farm, Walsham le Willows.

The Trust's income is divided into three parts all for the benefit of the inhabitants of the parish:

- 1. **Westhorpe Parochial Church Council** for the upkeep and services for St Margaret's Church;
- 2. The **Education Foundation** which gives every child a book token at Christmas. Those at university, college or other forms of Further or Higher Education or apprenticeships are given grants each academic year towards tuition fees, travel expenses, books, computers and other essential equipment. Help is also offered with other expenses such as school uniform, books and possibly school trips for those in nursery, primary and secondary school as well as others taking educational courses.
- 3. The **Village Fund** provides family and personal grants for any kind of assistance, emergency payments, help with transport and heating costs, grants towards village events and many other things which need funding and are of benefit to the parish.
