

## **ADVENT....and CHRISTMAS**

Whilst there is every reason to be both cautious and vigilant as we go about our daily lives, it is to be hoped that the Seasons of Advent and Christmas can be celebrated this year with a degree more freedom and normality than was the case last year.

Advent Season will have begun within our Parish churches on Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> November, and then throughout December all six of our churches will hold their respective Carol Services with a much welcome return to singing. Langham church will host a somewhat informal carol service which will incorporate a Christingle service, Walsham church will have their ever popular Crib service upon the afternoon of Christmas Eve; (see elsewhere in the magazine for details of all the services). As always there will be a warm welcome at all our churches.

Advent, the period leading up to Christmas, is a time of waiting; for Christians a time of waiting for Christmas and the birth of Jesus. Waiting is perhaps something that society no longer has to do too much of these days.

Apps downloaded on a smartphone keep us updated as to precisely when the bus is due and which trains have been cancelled or are running late. They can tell us how long our journey by car will take. Technology enables delivery companies to predict within 30 minutes when the parcel will arrive. We no longer need to look out expectantly for the arrival of a letter from a loved one; e-mail is instantaneous. Once an international phone call had to be booked in advance and the family waited for the appointed time to speak to a son or daughter abroad to wish a Happy Christmas; no longer the case. We are told that we can take the 'waiting out of wanting' if we sign up for a credit card. Using the most modern technology, instant gratification can be ours.

## A-peat for Mary Tudor

### Restoration of the bells in St Margaret's Church, Westhorpe

The appeal for the proposed restoration of the church bells got off to a flying start at the Appeal Launch held in the village hall on 21<sup>st</sup> October. The project is being managed by a small steering group who aim to raise the required funds, in the region of £100,000.

Members of the Suffolk Guild of Ringers attended the event and the audience was enthralled by their Public Relations Officer, Neal Dodge's illustrated talk on the history of Westhorpe's bells and some of the ringers. Recent dendrochronology dating revealed that the timber in the present bell frame was felled between 1419 and 1440. The old bell is pre-Reformation, a rarity in the county, c15<sup>th</sup> century and is inscribed in Latin and translated *Saint Mary pray for us*. This history links into the will of Elizabeth de Elmham who, in her extensive will dated 1419, left £40 for the finishing of the tower and the bells. Mary Tudor living at Westhorpe Hall in the 16<sup>th</sup> century would have heard the bells of St Margaret's ringing out hence our Appeal is dedicated to her name.

Since the Launch, residents have fully embraced the project and offers of fundraising and pledged donations are already being received. To that end, congratulations and thanks are due to Ricky Wilkinson who participated in the Ride and Stride in September and raised £335.00; half of which will be given, at his request, to the bell fund. Ricky has also undertaken the role of British Legion poppy co-ordinator in the village, a task which his late wife, Heather, did for so many years.

## **CRANBERRY CHUTNEY**

The perfect accompaniment to cold meats or cheese.

450g (1lb) cranberries, 450g (1lb) apples, 225g (1/2 oz) sugar, 170g (6oz) raisins, 285ml (1/2pt) vinegar, 1 tsp of salt, 1 tsp of mixed spice, 2tsp pickling spice (in a muslin bag)

Peel, core and cop apples; put in a pan with half the vinegar; add all the other ingredients except sugar; simmer till fruit is soft. Add remaining vinegar and sugar, stirring till dissolved; boil slowly till thick, remove muslin bag before potting.

Spoon the hot chutney into sterilised jars and seal. Store unopened in a cool, dark place.  
The chutney will keep for up to 6 months. Chill on opening.




