



Look out for further workshops. We all asked Katie if she would be doing another session and she said she hoped to organise another one soon.



NOTES FROM THE GARDEN

Hello, now I am no Monty Don (just a little younger) but I am looking forward to writing about gardening and sharing my experiences in the future. I feel lucky I was in a time with my dad when the family garden was a very important part of life. Money was short so when we moved into a house with a large back garden, dad set about providing produce for the family table with four children to feed.

I was about 12 years old when dad taught me how to dig, double digging was my first experience going down two spits (spade depths) so as to really turn over the soil. Also adding rotten manure from the farm up the road transported by me and my brother by a wheelbarrow which then was put into the trench. My dad showed me how to do this and corrected me when it was not right....or straight. A memory I will never forget. Setting up the garden like this and rotating crops was key to success. Making seed beds but not stepping on the soil was a great learning curve.

When I was at Beyton secondary school we had a rural studies department, it was a wonderful experience and was run by Mr Charles Foat. We learnt how to look after the soil, plant and harvest crops which were sometimes used in the school kitchen, chickens and other animals were studied as well. Sadly this is no longer a school subject, nowadays some primary schools are getting children involved by planting raised beds etc. Getting the children involved in nature with its wonders and fresh food, which they have grown also encourages them to eat healthy produce.

Life today is different, many people have not the time or the garden space to be taught what my dad showed me, but there is always the allotment (another story). Now is the time to look into the garden in your pots and baskets to find self seedlings from your previous plants, put these in some compost to see what grows (pot luck!). Divide perennials and grasses for free plants too. By the time you read this things will be moving on in the garden (if the rain ceases) and another garden adventure begins. Until next time.





CITIZENS ADVICE



My council tax bill is coming out in March, and I am dreading opening it as it always goes up. My income has stayed the same but everything else seems more expensive and I have hardly anything left over - how will I cope if my payments for this year go up?

Many of us are feeling overwhelmed as we see our basic bills and essential costs go up. You're not alone in finding things difficult and, crucially, there's support available.

First off, there are discounts available to some people depending on their circumstances. You can check your bill or contact your council to find out if you might be eligible for an automatic reduction to your council tax.

If you're not getting a discount, you might still be entitled to one. It depends on who lives in the property. So, if you're the only adult in your home, you'll get a 25% discount on your council tax bill.

When working out how many people live in a property, some people aren't counted they're called 'disregarded people' and include under 18s, a student nurse or someone on an apprenticeship scheme and many more. Checking the government website (https://www.gov.uk/council-tax/who-has-to-pay) for more details. If everyone who lives in the property is disregarded, you will still receive a council tax bill, but it will have a 50% discount. However, if everyone in your home is a student or severely mentally impaired, you won't pay any council tax.

Additionally, if someone has moved out, tell the council as this might change your eligibility. If you are entitled to a discount as a result, it will be valid from the date when the person moved out, even if you told the council after the event, and the reduction may be backdated.

If you think you might be eligible you should apply to your local council for a discount as soon as possible. You can find your council's contact details via https://www.gov.uk/apply-for-council-tax-discount

You mention that your income hasn't increased. If you are on a low income, you might be able to get your council tax reduced. If you get benefits or have other people living with you, this might affect how much your council tax is reduced by.

Your local council will ask you details about your income and your circumstances, so they can work out if you're entitled to a council tax reduction. They will then calculate your new bill and tell you how much council tax you need to pay.

If you have other people living with you who are aged 18 or over, you might all be responsible for paying council tax. Only one of you needs to apply for a council tax reduction. The council will make a decision and reduce the amount of council tax you have to pay accordingly.

You may also be eligible for additional support if you've reached State Pension age which you can check on the government website via https://www.gov.uk/state-pensionage. If you're under State Pension age, the 'working age rules' apply and if you've reached State Pension age, it depends if you or your partner get certain benefits.

The working age rules still apply if you've reached State Pension age and you or your partner get:

Universal Credit Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA) Income-related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA) Income Support

If you've reached State Pension age and don't get any of these benefits, the 'pension age rules' apply.

Even if none of the reduction criteria applies to you, your local council can still reduce your council tax bill or cancel it altogether, this is called 'discretionary reduction'. They'll normally only do this if you can show that you're suffering severe hardship and can't afford to pay council tax.

If you're in this situation you should ask your local council for help. You'll need to show them evidence of your circumstances. If your immigration status doesn't let you claim public funds, you can still apply for a discretionary reduction. A discretionary reduction doesn't count as public funds.

We know that times are incredibly tough and council tax is a priority bill so it's important to keep in contact with your council if you can't keep up payments. Citizens Advice is here to help you find a way forward, without judgement, working with you side by side.
