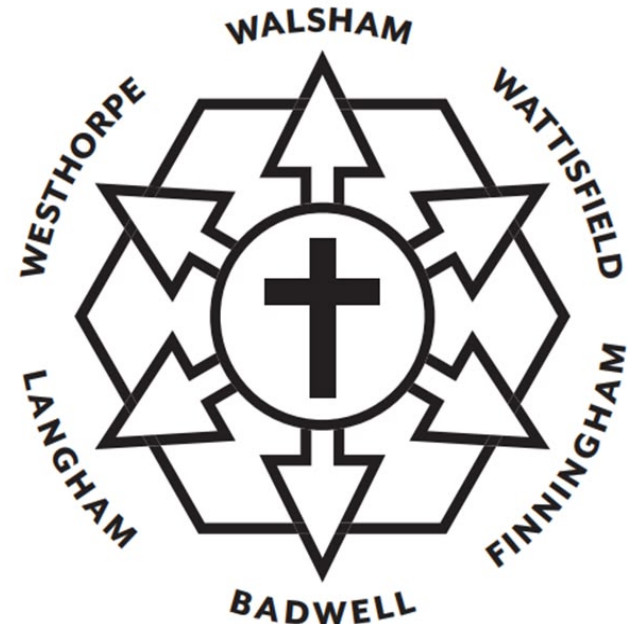

NOTES FROM THE GARDEN

Hello again, well there was a lot of weather in February / March, mostly wet, chilly and cold, making it unpleasant to work outside. Hopefully as the days lengthen it will become drier and warmer.

In April seeds and plants will be on the move. Plant out the rest of your second early and main crop potatoes, earthing them up to protect them from frosts. If not already done plant out your onion sets and shallots and vegetables like broad beans, peas, spinach, swiss chard in your raised beds. Keep on top of weeds by hoeing between the rows as soon as the weeds appear. Plant peas with netting or sticks directly into the soil making successive sowings to enable a continuous supply during the year. Do the same with your other salad and vegetables. In the poly tunnel things are warming up, you can put in plants and seeds that will be protected from the weather and more advanced than the same type outside.

Sow your bedding and container basket flower seeds into plugs and trays for summer and autumn colour. Your baskets, pots and containers should be cleaned and refilled with fresh compost, ready for your plants at the end of May when frosts should be less of a concern. Hanging Lobelia is a great gap filler for your baskets and pots. All your favourite plants can be grown from seed this way will be a lot cheaper. Fuchsias, Geraniums and Begonias and Nasturtiums can be planted directly in position, keeping an eye out for late frosts.

Climbing plants, such as Clematis, Honeysuckle, and Jasmine will have to be tied to the trellis to prevent wind damage and shape. In April don't be too eager to cut back foliage of spring bulbs as this will deny the bulb time to recover for next year. We plant ours in aquatic baskets, then lift them out place in a quiet spot in the garden to die back, leaving you to fill the space earlier.

In April / May plants are not the only things to wake up, slugs, snails, and other pests will be hungry as well. Check your Hosta shoots and Foxgloves, Primulas, and other plants removing them as you see them to prevent damage. In May take time to sit in your garden, tunnel, or greenhouse, and watch all your efforts come to fruition.

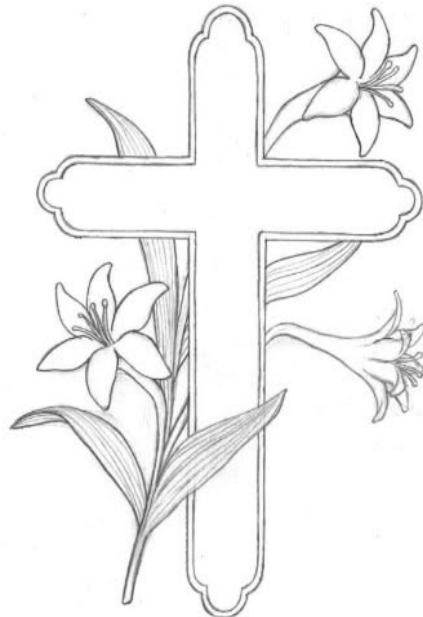

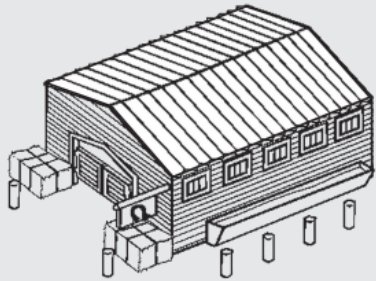

UK COMMUNITY CARE

Question – My elderly parents are becoming frail as time goes by, I need to get to know about aids and equipment and possibly a bathroom change. Do I approach Social Services first and what can they help with?

Answer – For an older person who needs support of any kind to remain as independent as possible, the first thing to do is to contact Social Services and ask for a free Care Needs Assessment. Following an assessment, Social Services may make an appointment for an Occupational Therapist (OT) to visit before deciding what aids or adaptations are needed. Social Services can provide free equipment and funds for minor adaptations up to £1000 in England and Wales. For major adaptations, it may be possible to apply for a Disabled Facilities Grant, if you are eligible.

Question – If I get a call from my bank, I am now suspicious as you hear so much about fraud. What is the advice if ‘my bank’ says it is calling me?

Answer – You are right to be suspicious as nearly 75 percent of attempted frauds are conducted via telephone, with 60 percent through voice calls and 11 percent via text messages.

The Safety Advice is:

If you receive a suspicious call about your bank account or finances, hang up immediately and dial 159. This free service, now available to 27 UK banks and building societies, covering over 99% of UK current accounts, connects you directly to your bank's fraud team, helping protect you from financial scams.

Fraudsters often create a sense of urgency, pressuring you to move money or share personal details quickly. Remember - your bank will never ask you to transfer money to a 'safe account' or pressure you into making immediate decisions.

If in doubt, always hang up and call 159 to verify whether the call was genuine. Since its launch in 2021, over one million calls have been made to 159 so taking a moment to check could save you from significant financial loss.

Question – I find it difficult to get an appointment at my GP surgery, sometimes having to wait two weeks or more? Is there anything I can do?

Answer – Yes, you may be able to if you have a community pharmacy.

Pharmacy First is an NHS England initiative launched in 2024. With **Pharmacy First**, you can walk into your local community pharmacy and ask for a private consultation with a pharmacist. They can assess symptoms, give advice, and in some cases provide NHS treatment — all without needing to see a GP first.

This is especially helpful for:

- Older adults needing quick advice
- Families with children who are unwell
- Carers supporting relatives

Just go in and ask: “Can I have a **Pharmacy First** consultation, please?”

CITIZENS ADVICE



I bought a doll for my child recently. I thought it was manufactured by a well-known brand, but I suspect it might be counterfeit. How can I be sure and what are my rights?

You're right to seek advice about this issue, because counterfeit goods aren't only illegal, they can be dangerous.

Fake children's toys in particular, including dolls, often don't meet safety standards and can pose choking hazards - poor manufacturing can mean small parts are easily detachable. Counterfeit goods are fake products designed to mimic the authentic ones sold by genuine brands. Sometimes it's easy to spot a knock-off, other times it can be harder to tell.

It's not just toys and games - things like clothing, footwear, e-cigarettes, perfumes and media devices can also be counterfeit. Things to watch out for include strangely low prices from well-known brands and signs of poor quality - like missing security seals, bad or non-existent packaging, blurry logos and poor stitching. You may also spot some spelling mistakes in the advert or on the packaging.

Looking at photos from official sellers can help when making comparisons, and it's important to only buy products from reputable sellers.

If you have purchased a counterfeit item, there are some steps you can take to try and get your money back. You're legally entitled to a full refund on fake goods within 30 days of your purchase. If it's been over 30 days since you paid, but less than six months, the seller can provide you with a real version of the item first. If they can't, then they're legally required to give you a full refund.

If you paid more than six months ago, you're only entitled to a part-refund based on how much you've used the item and how long you've had it.

Sometimes sellers might refuse to refund you, and argue the items were obviously fake because they were very cheap, but they're breaking the law by selling them and your legal rights still apply.

If this happens and you paid by debit card, contact your bank and ask to use the 'chargeback scheme'. If you paid by credit card and the item cost less than £100, you can ask to use the same scheme.

If you paid by credit card and the item cost between £100 and £30,000, tell your credit card company you want to make a 'section 75' claim to get your money back. To report counterfeit goods or get help getting your money back, contact the Citizens Advice Consumer Service. You can also report a seller to Trading Standards, which investigates criminal activity.

Citizens Advice Mid Suffolk can provide in depth advice on this issue and much more, including debt, finances, employment, benefits and family/relationships. 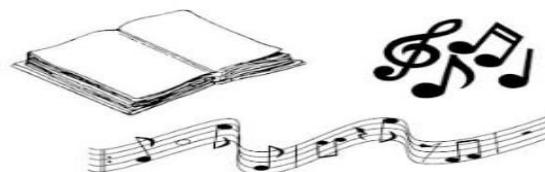

LPG COMMUNITY BUYING GROUP - COLLECTIVE SAVINGS OF £1830 TO DATE

It is now 1 year since I tentatively suggested to the local community the formation of a bulk LPG buying group. Presently there are 7 members, fewer than I originally envisioned. However, from little acorns, big oak trees grow.

The group has evolved differently to my visualisation (that of emulating the many oil buying groups throughout the country). Instead it has become more of an informal chat forum where information is exchanged on gas prices, contracts and customer service. Supporting each other on negotiating new supplier contracts is key as there is a dearth of information published on LPG prices and supplier contracts; all to the benefit of the supplier/distributors who seek to increase prices (and profit margin) despite the wholesale price of LPG declining by 21% in the last two years.

Of the group members who have recently renewed their supplier contracts a very healthy saving of £1830 has been achieved. A good outcome on which to build.
